Our debt reduction kickoff was a huge success! We love your individual and team names.

Here are a few tips to follow when making a debt reduction donation, especially if you are on a team:

Remember the goal is to pay off our mortgage in 2025!!!

- On your offering envelope, please write "Debt Reduction" or "Project Impact" in the section labeled, 'Other.'
- If you are contributing as a member of a team, be sure to also include both *your* name and the name of your team on the envelope.
- If you are contributing via Givelify or Cash App, please note your team's name in the memo section.
- For those who write checks or money orders, there are several ways you can assist in the recording of both your regular offering and debt reduction contributions: You can write two (2) separate checks, cash split, or do a mixed contribution of cash & check. Regardless of how you give, the envelope must note where you want your contributions applied.

Although we record individual and team contributions, your designated team captain should also keep a record to capture individual member's contributions.

Finally, if you have not made a commitment to help with debt reduction, it's not too late to do so. With everyone's commitment to giving, we are confident that as a church we will meet the goal of becoming a debt free place of worship or facility.
